The Verona Area School District is proud to offer the Two-Way Immersion (TWI) Program, a dual language education program in which two languages are used for instruction in order to develop language proficiency in both languages.



What is the Program?

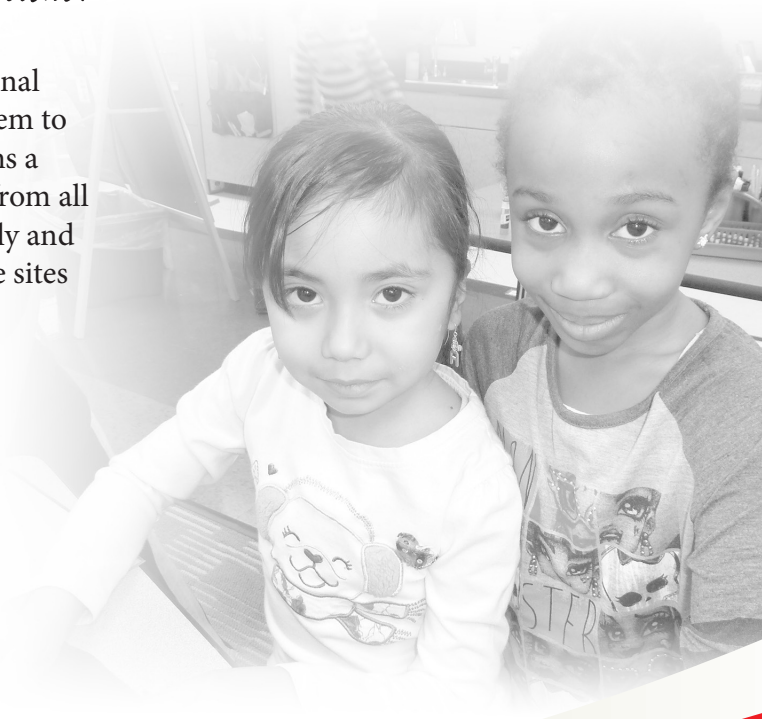
TWI brings together students to learn 50% of their academic content in Spanish and 50% in English. Our TWI Program will include a classroom make-up of approximately half native Spanish speakers and half native English speakers who will learn together in the classroom.

Who Can Enroll in the Program?

TWI is an option for parents who have children entering kindergarten. Final selection will be based on a lottery system to help ensure the TWI program maintains a balanced class composition. Students from all attendance areas in the district can apply and will be provided transportation to these sites if chosen for the TWI program.
