

Parental Rights to Seek Information Regarding Staff Qualifications

All teachers employed by the Verona Area School District (VASD) have at least a bachelor's degree, and many, approximately 75 percent, have a Masters' degree or equivalent. All VASD teachers are DPI licensed for their assignment. Finally, all instructional aides employed by VASD are considered qualified for their work assignments.

Federal law requires schools to share information with parents who ask about the qualifications of teachers employed by the school district. Parents may ask for information concerning licensure, waiver of any requirements, major(s) and degrees held. Parents can also ask about instructional aides working with their children and their qualifications.
