Nope. It's a heavy lift helicopter subcontracted by Findorff to place the new air handling units on the Verona High School! This past Saturday, six air handling units were placed onto the high school in just under 18 minutes by Midwest Helicopter Airways.

This lift is a big milestone for the renovation work on the exterior of the existing Verona schools. Future work to come on the school grounds will include new utility work, new playgrounds, and some new landscaping. As far as the interior work goes, some small demolition has already begun. Over the next three months the New Badger Ridge, K-Wing, and New Sugar Creek buildings will be getting a series of mechanical upgrades, a handful of bathroom remodels, and a number of office and classroom modifications!

DID YOU KNOW?

Did you know that the first residential air conditioner was over 7 feet high, 6 feet wide, and 20 feet long. The current Verona High School was built in 1968 and now, 52 years later, will be getting equipped with air conditioning. These air conditioning units are approximately 1/35th the size measuring roughly 6 feet wide, 4 feet tall, and just 8 inches long.
