VISIONING SESSION #2 SUMMARY

In our second visioning session we reviewed five GUIDING PRINCIPLES (link below) that summarize our goals for the new high school. These principles were built from the engagment activity in the first Visioning Session (word/image exercise) and the feedback from student engagment and staff input. These statements will serve as a framework to evaluate designs.

A presentation of slides provided a visual recap of the SCHOOL TOURS (link below). Our discussions focused on aspects of the school's layout, amenities, and interior design. We are identifying qualities that we want to incorporate, improve on, or avoid. This led into the exercise of "Stop. Start. Continue." and a dialogue about our current teaching preferences, spaces, and our vision for the future. Staff feedback is an important part of our ongoing conversations - *keep it coming!*

Finally, we manipulated building components on a physical map of the new high school site, establishing priorities for space assignment and building mass. EUA designers are working on a comprehensive layout that addresses our needs and provides flexibility. A few of our ideas include:

- Dedicated entry points, with main entry on the north side of the site
- · Learning studios grouped by core content with adjacency to similar subjects
- Science classrooms/labs stacked vertically for efficiency
- Library Media Center centrally located
